Our RE lessons will focus on the theme of Prophecy and Promise. Through this topic, we will explore significant people in the Old Testament such as David and Saul. We will look at model of a shepherd as a leader. During this unit of work, we will also learn more about the Rosary. We will also be completing work on the Jubilee Year.		Our fiction work in English will focus on classical fiction. Our primary text will be The Wizard of Oz. We will complete a variety of reading and writing activities on the story. We will also use The Wizard of Oz as the content to explore other genres of writing. For example, we will write a discussion text on whether a good wizard ask you to kill someone even if that person was wicked.		Our mathematics lessons follow the Power Maths scheme. Year 5 will begin with work on factors, multiples, prime numbers and square numbers. They will then focus on fractions. Year 6 will focus on fractions this half term. We will continue to complete arithmetic based work. Please encourage and support your child to go on Times Tables Rockstars at home.		
Science		Computing			Geography/History	
Our Science lessons will focus on ethe circulatory system. We will learn what is blood made of and why we need it. We will learn why our bodies need nutrients and how they are transported. We will then look at the functions of the heart.		In Computing this half term, we will use micro:bit to explore the following: what designing an electronic product involves, which programming software is best to achieve a purpose and the building blocks of computational thinking, for example, sequence, selection, repetition, variables, inputs and outputs.			Our focus for this half term will be Geography. On work will be on biomes and vegetation belts. We will start by building on prior knowledge of continents, lines of latitude and longitude though exploring major cities in the world. We will then learn about biomes and how biomes change across the world.
