| In maths, we will be using the Power Maths scheme. This half-term Y3 will work on multiplication and division, length and perimeter, fractions, mass and capacity. Y4 will work on multiplication and division, fractions, length and perimeter and decimals. Year 4 children will also begin working towards their MTC (Multiplication Tables Check) which takes place in the summer term. On the maths page of the school website, there are links to resources to help with this. | In English we will be looking at two key fictional texts – Kai and the Monkey King and the Man who walked between towers. | Our science topic for the first half term is plants and then we move on to forces. |
| RE | Computing | History |
| Our RE lessons will look at the churches calendar and community. | In computing this half-term, we will learn about sending emails and then we move on to learning about networks and the internet. | Our topic focus is ancient Rome and their invasion of Britain. For the next half term we move on to Geography. |
| Geography | Music | French |
| We will study a geography unit in the second half term. This will be to name and locate counties and cities of the United Kingdom, geographical regions and their identifying human and physical characteristics, key topographical features (including hills, mountains, coasts, and rivers), and land-use patterns; and understand how some of these aspects have changed over time. | In music this half-term we will be looking at the band Abba and their song Mama Mia. We will be learning the lyrics and learning how to play instruments to accompany the song. We will also explore other songs by Abba. | In French we will be learning the vocabulary for a French classroom before moving on to a unit titled Bon Appetit! Exploring French foods. |
