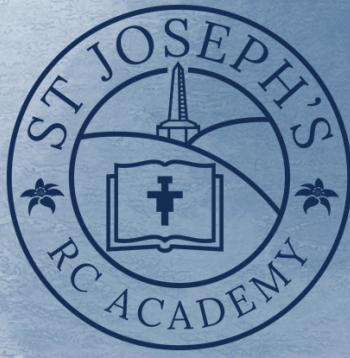

🎉 100% Attendance – Amazing Achievement! 🎉

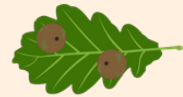
We are thrilled to celebrate 100% attendance on Thursday – every single child in school and ready to learn! What a fantastic team effort from our pupils and families.

The children were a credit to the school and ended the day with a well-earned treat. Even Ms Green managed to put her feet up for a well-deserved rest — and we have the photo to prove it!

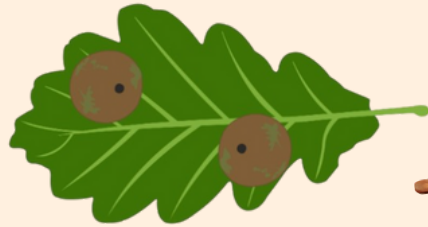

Oak Apples Forest School



This week at Forest School, children across Beech, Cedar, Elm and Oak classes took part in thoughtful and creative sessions inspired by Valentine's Day, focusing on love, care and working together.

Beech and Cedar explored what love means to them and who and what they care about. Using sticks, grass and leaves, the children worked together to create large love hearts on the Forest School floor, as well as smaller woven heart shapes using ribbons and string. The children showed excellent teamwork, concentration and creativity throughout the session.

Elm and Oak classes took part in an outdoor first aid session, learning how to care for others and respond in emergency situations. The children practised calling for help, explored a first aid kit, and confidently role-played scenarios including placing someone into the recovery position. They showed great maturity, compassion and teamwork.

A lovely week of learning focused on kindness, care and looking out for one another.

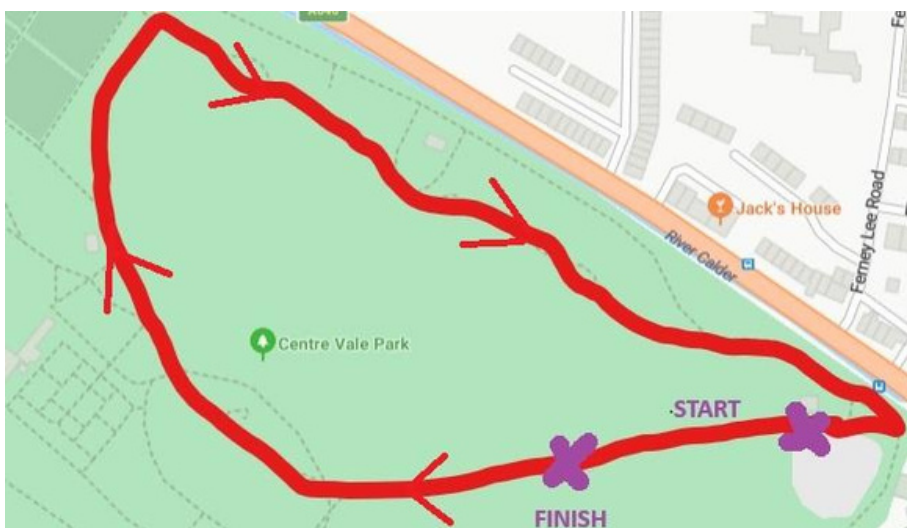
