Year 2s will continue looking mass, capacity and temperature and then they will be moving onto multiplication and division using our scheme Power Maths.		In English we will be looking at 'The Prince who Wrote Stories'. Our writing focus will be on the opening and ending of the story.  We will then move onto writing an information report.		In Science this half term, we will be looking at Plants. Children will be observing and describing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. find out and describe how plants need water, light, and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.
