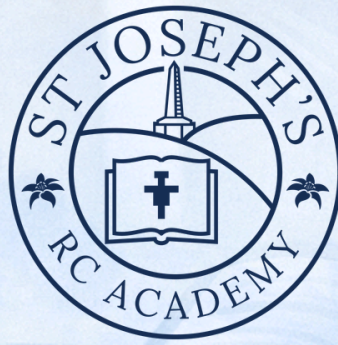

Please continue to support us by ensuring pupils attend school every day and arrive on time, unless they are unwell.



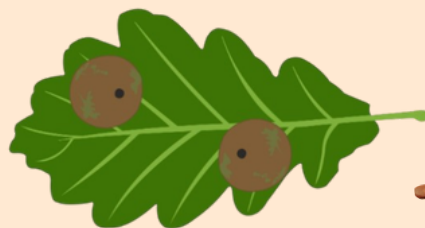

This week at...

Oak Apples Forest School



This week, children across Beech, Cedar, Elm and Oak classes enjoyed a variety of exciting Forest School activities, developing their confidence, teamwork, creativity and practical outdoor skills.

Beech Class were delighted to welcome their families to Forest School, where they enjoyed den building, flint and steel activities, wildflower planting, nature collages and potion making. The session ended with a special celebration around the fire circle, where children received a Golden Acorn award in recognition of their achievements throughout the half term.

Cedar Class demonstrated fantastic independence as they explored den building and practised using flint and steel, showing great perseverance and teamwork as they attempted to create their own fire safely.

Elm Class focused on den building, working collaboratively to design and construct a shelter large enough for the whole group. The children showed excellent communication, problem-solving and resilience throughout the session.

Oak Class enjoyed a relaxed session developing their practical Forest School skills. They built and lit their own fires, safely used knives for whittling, toasted marshmallows and helped improve the Forest School environment by strengthening existing den structures.
