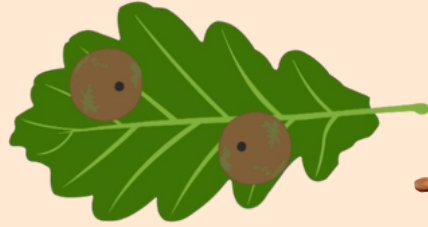

Oak Apples Forest School



Today, our Year 6 children enjoyed a fantastic Forest School adventure, travelling by train from Todmorden to Mytholmroyd before walking up to the Forest School site in Cragg Vale. Despite the challenging walk, the children showed great enthusiasm, resilience, and determination throughout.

Once there, the children had the opportunity to explore the woodland, take part in free exploration, and develop their confidence through a range of outdoor activities. They worked together to put up hammocks, built a den, explored the pond area where they discovered froglets and a dragonfly nymph, and enjoyed spotting wildlife and insects around the site.

The campfire was a real highlight of the day, with children helping to collect wood, safely tend the fire, whittle sticks, and toast crumpets. They also enjoyed eating lunch together around the fire, creating a wonderful sense of community and teamwork.

The rope swing was a firm favourite, with children showing confidence, patience, and excellent awareness of safety while taking turns. Later in the afternoon, they cooled down in the stream before helping to tidy the area and leave the site as they found it.



It was a wonderful day full of adventure, discovery, and learning. The children demonstrated teamwork, independence, problem-solving, and a real appreciation for the natural environment. They returned tired but very happy after a truly memorable Forest School experience!
