Parents are missing out on important messages sent from school if they have got their notifications switched off.


We send lots of reminders and important information out via messaging and the cost savings for school are huge.

How to apply for a school place

Children born between 1 September 2017 and 31 August 2018 are due to start primary school in September 2022.

To apply for a school place you must apply online by 15 January 2022 at www.calderdale.gov.uk/admissions.

If you would like a leaflet about applying for a primary school place please contact your preferred school and register your child's name. The leaflet will then be distributed by the primary school at the end of November 2021.

The application process opens on 19 November 2021 and the close date is 15 January 2022

Offers of school places will be made on 19 April 2022.
